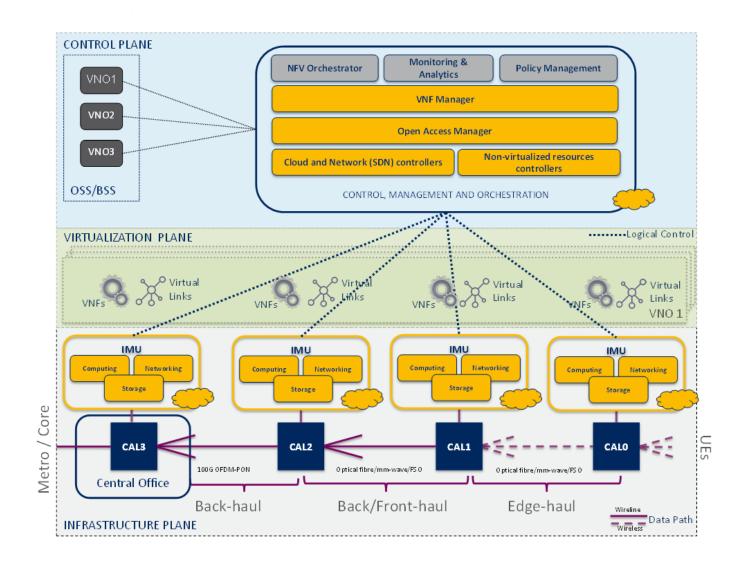

CHARISMA Proposed architecture







- Low latency
 - Intelligence close to the edge
 - New use cases (healthcare, transportation, media, etc.)
- Open access
 - Infrastructure owners can share their resources with network operators
 - Personalized services meeting their demand criteria

• Security

- Holistic management platform, end to end security
- Critical for the adoption of 5G



CHARISMA Business models in CHARISMA

- A business model consists of a description of all the business players, their roles and relationships, their relative position within the value network and a description of the cost structure and possible sources of revenues
- A network of relationships that generates economic and other types of value through dynamic exchanges, that may be tangible or intangible, between two or more participating players.



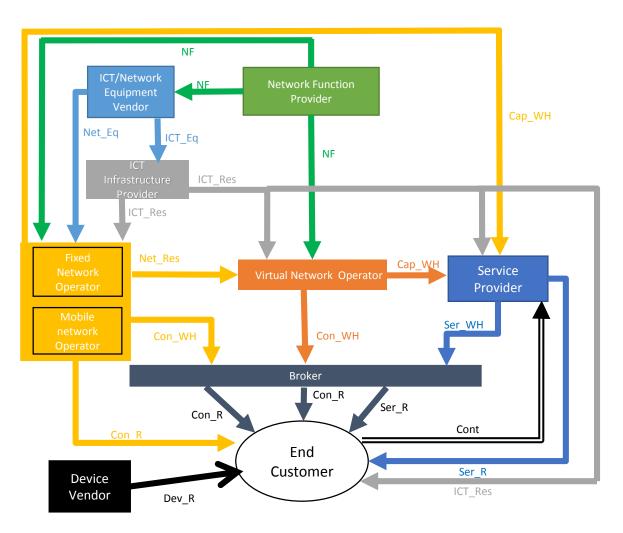


Definitions

- **Player**: an entity that participates in the business model. It can provide or consume services (from other entities);
- **Role**: The functionalities of each player that participates in the business model. Players can take one or more of these roles;
- **Relationship**: it illustrates the interaction between two roles or players in the model;
- **Revenue model**: it describes the revenue streams for a player in the model.
