



BigO: Big Data Against Childhood Obesity

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Aim

The societal problem of soaring obesity rates among children is being tackled by EU-funded project BigO.

Collecting and analyzing big anonymous data on children's behavioral patterns and their environment, BigO will extract evidence on which local factors are involved and how they influence childhood obesity.

BigO will enable public health authorities to plan, develop, and execute effective programs against obesity.

BigO Approach

- Evidence exists that interventions targeting various elements of children's behavioural patterns, like what and how they eat, how they move and how they sleep and environmental community factors, can have a positive outcome against childhood obesity
- 25 000 school children 9 -18 years old invited to be part of the BigO Community as "citizen scientists" and help with the data collection using mobile phones and smart watches.





- Large scale data collection
- Analytics to extract associations between obesogenic behaviours and environment
- Public health stakeholder engagement to evaluate outcomes
- Teach young European citizens about the principles of Voluntarism, Citizen Science and Public Participation






- Increasing the awareness about healthy living, introducing students to the health-in-all-things mentality
- Share aggregated evidence with public health authorities and schools to help design and monitor obesity programs
- Share individual behavioural patterns with health professionals to aid childhood obesity





BigO platform




- Collects behaviour and local environment data
- ✓ Develops intelligent algorithms to recognize behavioural patterns
- ✓ Visualizes **individual behavioural patterns** for health professionals to help them followup obese child patients
- ✓ Visualizes aggregated evidence for public health authorities and schools to help them design and monitor programs
- Extracts associations between environment and obesogenic behaviours to investigate causality





Data collection

 - Accelerometry
 - GPS
 - Pictures of meals/food ads taken by the user
 - Answers to questions
- ✓ Connects to *WearOS*smartwatches





Behaviour indicators


Individual and group views






Behaviour indicators

2/2






- ✓ Time, type of meal

Physical activity map - Larissa




How much and where do students move in the city of Larissa?

✓ Privacy aware implementation based on geohash votes and avoiding storing of GPS coordinates of child's location






Physical activity map - Athens
